Saint Martin de Porres School is a Pre-K through Grade 8 Catholic parish-based elementary school that is sponsored by Saint Martin de Porres Parish and has been teaching Catholic values since 1964.

Saint Martin de Porres School follows the curriculum approved by the Archdiocese of New York and the guidelines of the Archdiocese of New York in teaching religion.

The spiritual growth of each student is enhanced by regular celebration of the Eucharist, Catholic devotions, and daily prayer.

We house a state of the art multi-media center as well as computers and interactive Smart TVs in all classrooms. Students of PreK-3 through grade 6 use the iPads and tablets daily. In grades 7 and 8, there is a one-to-one iPad program where each student has an individual iPad for daily school and home use. Our systems technology is infused into the daily classroom lessons, as well as including several digital libraries.

Saint Martin de Porres School students score consistently higher than the national and state medians on state and standardized tests. Saint Martin de Porres School was recognized by the U.S. Department of Education as a 2012 National Blue Ribbon School, based on overall academic excellence.

Academic Enrichment Programs are offered in Pre-Kindergarten through 4th grade.

Advanced Math is offered in Grades 5 through 7.
